Minutes of the previous regular meeting of April 20, 2020 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment. Sandy McGrath, Environmental Health gave an update on the results of testing at the Prestage Plant. They tested 867 people with 25 showing positive for CO-VID all being asymptomatic. Eighteen of the people were from Black Hawk County, one person is from Wright County with the balance from surrounding counties They are planning on doing serological testing starting this week.
Cindy Litwiller, Wright County Economic

Development, presented the promissory installment note with Belmond Industrial Development Corporation (BIDCO). The loan is to provide immediate and necessary assistance to small business who may be adversely affected by changes in business or regulations imposed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The loan to BIDCO is for \$25,000 at 0% interest for 15 years to be paid in full back to Economic Development on May 31, 2035. There was then a motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to approve the loan to BIDCO as outlined above.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to receive the Wright County Recorder quarterly revenue report. Mo-

Held a conference call with Eric with ISG and Brian at Reilly Construction on the Agri-Business Park.

At 9:30 a.m. held a Zoom web/telecon-ference call with Franklin County on Joint Drainage District #118-4 was held to accept and grant a bid for repair work proposed in JDD 118-4 Open Ditch and Lateral #2. Said bids were submitted and opened at the March 23, 2020 Board

meeting.
Lee Gallentine, Drainage Engineer, explained the bids presented from the March 23, 2020 Board meeting and reported that all numbers and bid bonds were acceptable. Gallentine stated that a letter was received from NRCS concerning the proposed project and jurisdictional wetlands. The ruling from NRCS is that the project will not impact jurisdictional wetlands. One landowner expressed his concern of this being a poor time to contract work due to corn prices being so low

Wright County Board of Supervisors reported that landowners in Wright County would not have any direct financial impact with this repair since all work will be done in Franklin County. To date Wright County has not received any opposition from landowners. Motion by McVicker and seconded by Kluss to accept the bid

from Mountain Movers Dirt Work, Rowan, Iowa, for repairs in JDD 118-4 Open Ditch of \$262,670.77; and JDD 118-4 Lateral #2 of \$72,980.00; using concrete as the material of choice. All ayes. Motion

McKinley Bailey with Building Families met with the Board of Supervisors to discuss Child Care Funding. There was \$3,500 budgeted for new in home child care grants. There have been no new in home child care startups in Wright County so Bailey is requesting that the Board consider granting money bonus to the current Day Cares that stayed open during the COVID pandemic. Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the bonus funding to 33 day cares of \$253.12 each. The 33 are all registered day cares.

Colleen Meier, Communication Center Director, presented 3 bids on the remodel of the Communication Center. The bids were for putting in a wall, changing the flooring and taking out the raised floor, making an IT room, and open up room by taking out the closet between two rooms. The Construction bid will be paid out of Debt Service and the IT portion will be paid out of the E911 budget. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to accept the low bid of Bryan Russell of

Sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk of Clarion, Iowa at City Hall, 121 1s Street SW, P.O. Box 266, Clarion, Iowa 50525, before 2:00 p.m. on the 28th day of May, 2020, for the construction of the Water System Improvements Project in and for the City of Clarion, Iowa. At the above time and place all bids received by the City will be opened and publicly read with the results being reported to the Clarion City Council at their meeting on June 2nd, 2020 at 4:30 p.m., at City Hall, 121 1st Street SW. P.O. Box 266. Clarion. lowa, at which time and place the Council may take action on the proposals submitted or at such time as may then be fixed. The general description of types of construction and their limits for which bids

will be received shall be as follows: Removal and replacement of water main pipes, valves, fittings, services and hydrants. Includes associated storm sewer replacement, street, sidewalk, curb, and driveway patching, and all other restoration related to the replacement of the water main, hydrants, and services.

A more detailed description of the kinds and approximate quantities of materials and types of construction for which bids will be received are set forth in the Bid Form included in the specifications prepared by ISG (I&S Group, Inc.) of Storm Lake, Iowa, which, together with the proposed form of contract, are now on file for public examination in the office of the City Clerk, and are by this reference made part hereof as though fully set out and incorporated herein.

All proposals shall be made on official proposal forms furnished by the Engineer, and must be enclosed in a separate sealed envelope and plainly identified and addressed to the City of Clarion,

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a cashier's check or certified check drawn on a state-chartered or federally chartered bank, or a certified share draft drawn on a state-chartered or federally chartered credit union, or a bidder's bond with corporate surety satisfactory to the City in an amount equal to Ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the propos al. If bid bond is submitted, it must be in the form provided in these specifications. Said check or share draft may be cashed, or the bid bond forfeited as liquidated damages in the event the successful bid-der fails or refuses to enter into a contract within ten (10) days of issuance of a Notice of Award and post bond satisfactory to the City insuring the faithful fulfillment of the contract and mainte-nance of said improvements as required by law. The bid bond should be executed by a corporation authorized to contract as a surety in the State of Iowa, and must not contain any conditions either in the body or as an endorsement thereon.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a corporate surety bond in an amount equal to one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price, said bond to be issued by a responsible surety approved by the City, and shall guarantee the faithful performance of the contract and the terms and conditions therein contained, the payment for materials used in the project and the maintenance of said improvements in good repair for not less than one (1) year from the time of acceptance of said improvements by

The City reserves the right to defer acceptance of any proposal for a period not to exceed sixty (60) calendar days from the date of receipt of bids. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities

Payment of the cost of said project will be made from such cash funds of the City as may be legally used for said purpose at the discretion of the City, including but not limited to, the net revenues of the Water Department, the proceeds from the sale of Revenue or General Obligation Bonds, and/or the proceeds from the sale of warrants, as authorized by Section 384.57 of the Code of Iowa, made payable from any or all of the above-mentioned sources.

The Contractor will be paid ninety-five per cent (95%) of the Engineer's esti-mate of the value of acceptable work completed at the end of the preceding month. Final payment will be made not less than thirty-one (31) days after completion of the work and acceptance by the City, subject to the conditions and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 573 of the Code of Iowa.

No such final payment will be due until the Contractor certifies to the City that the materials, labor, and services involved in the final estimate have been paid for in accordance with the requirements stated in the specifications. The City of Clarion is exempt from paying Sales and Use Tax and will supply Contractor with an "lowa Sales Tax Exemption Certificate" and an authorization letter to allow the Contractor to buy equipment and material for the project tax free.

The work on this project shall commence within ten (10) days after receipt by the contractor of a written notice to proceed. All work associated with the installation of the water main, appurtenances, underground utilities, roadway patching, driveway and sidewalk paving and stoned surfacing shall be substan tially completed by June 1, 2021 with remaining site restoration and seeding to be substantially completed by July 1 2021, subject to any changes in the contract period as provided for in these specifications.

Liquidated damages in the amount of \$500 per calendar day will be assessed for each day that the work shall remain uncompleted after the above referenced completion date with due allowance for extensions of the contract period due to conditions beyond control of the Con-
